An angel comes to Joseph in a dream and tells him not to worry and to take Mary as his wife and welcome her into his home. He learns that Mary will bear a son, and that His name will be Emmanuel, which means "God is with us". Joseph answered God's call and said, "yes" to the job of knowing, loving and raising Jesus. Let's do the same this week, by looking around us and saying "yes" when we are given the chance to be the light of Jesus to others!
