6. From which book of the Bible is the Gospel reading?

What two questions did Jesus ask His disciples?

Who answered the second question, and what did he say?

7. Write down as much as you can about Sts. Peter and Paul. (For example, which one was one of the 12 Apostles? Which one was the first pope? What were their names before Jesus changed them? What did each of them do before he became a Christian?)
