

<p>When you are born you have original sin.</p> <p>(True)</p>	<p>You inherited original sin from the sin of Adam and Eve.</p> <p>(True)</p>
<p>The Sacrament of Baptism is the first Sacrament because it is the door to the Church and no other Sacrament can be received without it.</p> <p>(True)</p>	<p>Baptism only removes original sin.</p> <p>(False)</p>
<p>The one who ordinarily administers Baptism is a priest.</p> <p>(True)</p>	<p>Baptism is a second birth.</p> <p>(True)</p>
<p>When we are baptized, we receive a permanent mark on our souls.</p> <p>(True)</p>	<p>When we are baptized we become members of the Church.</p> <p>(True)</p>

<p>Baptism takes away original sin.</p> <p>(True)</p>	<p>When you are baptized it also takes away actual sin and all the punishment due to them if you are truly sorry for them.</p> <p>(True)</p>
<p>Only a priest can administer Baptism.</p> <p>(False)</p>	<p>If there is danger that someone will die without Baptism, anyone may and should baptize.</p> <p>(True)</p>
<p>Baptism is necessary for the salvation of all men because Christ has said, "Unless a man be born again of water and the spirit, he cannot enter into the kingdom of God." (True)</p>	<p>As you are being baptized, the priest says, "I baptize you in the name of the Father, and of the Son, and of the Holy Spirit." (True)</p>
<p>Baptism makes you a Christian.</p> <p>(True)</p>	<p>You receive your name at Baptism.</p> <p>(True)</p>
<p>Jesus was baptized in the Nile River.</p> <p>(False)</p>	<p>Jesus was baptized in the Jordan River.</p> <p>(True)</p>

<p>Baptism is the second of the sacraments.</p> <p>(False)</p>	<p>Baptism is the first sacrament.</p> <p>(True)</p>

<p>In Baptism, the oil reminds us we are chosen - "anointed" by God.</p> <p>(True)</p>	<p>In Baptism, the oil reminds us that the Holy Spirit will strengthen and protect because He has chosen us.</p> <p>(True)</p>
<p>Baptism, Confirmation, and the Eucharist are the 3 Sacraments of Initiation for the Catholic Church.</p> <p>(True)</p>	<p>During Baptism, a cross is made on your forehead with blessed ashes.</p> <p>(False)</p>
<p>If an older person is baptized only original sin is removed, not any Actual sins for which the person is truly sorry.</p> <p>(False)</p>	<p>The second important effect of the Sacrament of Baptism is the removal of original sin.</p> <p>(False)</p>
<p>Baptism does not remove all the punishment due to sin.</p> <p>(False)</p>	<p>If you immediately die after receiving the Sacrament of Baptism, the person would not need to suffer any punishment in Purgatory, but would go directly into heaven. (True)</p>
<p>Without the Sacrament of Baptism, no other Sacrament can or may be received.</p> <p>(True)</p>	<p>You do not have to receive the Sacrament of Baptism before receiving any other Sacrament.</p> <p>(False)</p>

<p>The Sacrament of Baptism is the first Sacrament because it was the first one instituted by Jesus. (False)</p>	<p>For the Sacrament of Baptism to be valid the correct words must be used while pouring the water on the forehead. (True)</p>
<p>We enter the Church by way of the Sacrament of Baptism. (True)</p>	<p>Baptism is essential for entering heaven. (True)</p>
<p>The priest uses ordinary water for Baptism. (True)</p>	<p>Those who through no fault of their own have not received the Sacrament of Baptism, can be saved by Baptism of Blood or Baptism of Desire. (True)</p>
<p>The Baptism of Desire is a Sacrament. (False)</p>	<p>Baptism is the Sacrament that gives our souls the new life of Sanctifying Grace. (True)</p>
<p>A person cannot receive the other Sacraments unless he has received the Sacrament of Baptism. (True)</p>	<p>A Baptismal promise is to renounce Satan and his works. (True)</p>
