How did Jesus respond to this sick man? Did He act disgusted?

Is there anyone in the world who is so sick, or ugly, or dirty that Jesus won't love and help them?

Blessed Father Damien lived in the 1800's, and was one of the very few people who was willing to help people with leprosy. He will be canonized and given the title of "saint" this year, by Pope Benedict XVI. Find out which state Blessed Father Damien lived in as a missionary to the lepers.
