1. What day is it, today, in the Church's calendar?
2. From which book of the Bible is the first reading?

Look in a Bible, in the Old Testament. What is the name of the book which comes right before this one?

What is the name of the book which comes right after this one?

3. From which Psalm is the Responsorial?
4. From which book of the Bible is the second reading?

Who wrote this letter?

This was written to the people of Ephesus. However it's too awkward to say "Ephesians" and besides it sounds silly. So we just call them "Ephesians."

This man probably wrote this letter while he was on house arrest; unable to leave his home and surrounded by guards day and night.

5. From which book of the Bible is the Gospel reading?
6. Did you start a prayer journal, last week? If not, try to this week. Or try another way to pray: Read a short passage from the Gospels. Now, close your eyes and imagine what it would have been like to actually be there. Take your time and notice the small details like the sunshine, the smells, the people around you. Imagine Jesus talking to you personally.
7. What are some other ways you can continue to grow in your faith, this summer? (Here are some ideas: Help in a soup kitchen, pray a decade of the Rosary every day, visit a Catholic website like [www.holychildhoodusa.org](http://www.holychildhoodusa.org) or go to Mass during the week.)
