1. What day is it, today, in the Church's calendar?

2. How many priests are celebrating Mass, today?

3. From which book of the Bible is the first reading?

Is this book from the Old or the New Testament?

4. From which Psalm is the Responsorial?

What is this Psalm about?

5. From which book of the Bible is the second reading?

In this reading, St. Paul tells us to use our freedom not to make *ourselves* happy but to serve others and to live by the Holy Spirit. How can kids your age "live by the Spirit"?

6. From which book of the Bible is the Gospel reading?

The Samaritans and the Jews hated each other, and so this Samaritan village did not welcome anyone who was Jewish or travelling to a Jewish destination, like Jerusalem. What did James and John want to do to the village after they refused to help Jesus and His followers?

What did Jesus do?

7. In answer to last week's question, the five parts of the Mass are: (1) Introductory Rite, (2) Liturgy of the Word, (3) Liturgy of the Eucharist, (4) Communion Rite, and (5) Concluding Rite.
