5. From which book of the Bible is today's Gospel reading?

6. Do you know when the Consecration takes place during Mass? Pay very close attention during this time, today. You should be especially quiet and reverent when the priest raises the bread and wine and it becomes the Body and Blood, Soul and Divinity of Jesus Christ.
