What Sacrament do we have to help us confess our sins and receive God's forgiveness?

This Sacrament can be received as often as you wish. The Church encourages us to go frequently (once every 2 months is reasonable for many kids) so that we may benefit from the grace we receive from it. When was the last time that *you* went to this Sacrament?

Before going to this Sacrament you need to prepare. There are many ways to do this: reading the 10 Commandments, thinking about how we wronged others, praying in front of a Crucifix, thinking of ways we missed chances to do kind deeds, reading an Examination of Conscience, and so on. How do you prepare for this Sacrament? (Remember, if you haven't memorized the Act of Contrition prayer, you can bring a copy with you to Confession! The priests don't mind.)

4. From which book of the Bible is today's second reading?
5. From which book of the Bible is today's Gospel reading?

The woman gave Jesus honor and respect. What did Jesus give to her?

Is there someone you need to forgive? Someone you're mad at or who's hurt you? Pray that God will give you the grace to forgive that person, and then enjoy the peace that comes with letting go of hatred and resentment!
