5. How are you doing on your Lenten resolutions? Do you need to change them; to make them more challenging or a bit easier? (Don't get discouraged if you haven't been able to keep your Lenten promises perfectly. God doesn't mind if we cheat now and then, as long as we try!)

6. What does "*Ecce Agnus Dei*" mean?

7. Answer to last week's question: *The Annunciation is when the angel Gabriel visited Mary and told her she would have a baby, the Son of God. It is the first Joyful Mystery.*
