1. What day is it, today, in the Church's calendar? (There are two names for this day.)

Who gave us Divine Mercy Sunday?

Recite the Divine Mercy Chaplet on a Rosary, this week. Instead of saying Our Fathers say:

*Eternal Father, I offer You the Body and Blood, Soul and Divinity
Of Your dearly beloved Son, our Lord Jesus Christ,
In atonement for our sins and the sins of the whole world.*

On each of the ten Hail Mary beads say:

For the sake of His sorrowful Passion, have mercy on us and on the whole world.

2. From which book of the Bible is today's first reading?

3. From which book of the Bible does our second reading come?

4. From which book of the Bible is today's Gospel reading?

What miracle occurred in this reading?

Which Apostle was not present when Jesus first appeared?

Did He believe that Jesus was alive when the others told him?

Have you ever seen Jesus in person? Remember Jesus' words, "Blessed are those who have not seen and have believed." That means that you are especially blessed!

5. Answer to last week's question: The week before Easter is called Holy Week. It includes Holy Thursday, when we commemorate Jesus' Last Supper. It also includes Good Friday, when we remember Jesus' Passion and Death. On Good Friday all of the tabernacles around the world will be empty. The sanctuary lights will not be lit and the doors of the tabernacle will be left open.
