1. What day is it, today, in the Church's calendar?
2. From which book of the Bible is today's first reading?

This reading is about a "friend" and his vineyard. However this is a symbolic reading. Who is the "friend" and what or who is the vineyard?

3. From which Psalm is today's Responsorial?
4. From which book of the Bible is today's second reading?

What types of things does God want us to think about?

This is very powerful advice. When a person fills his or her head with dark movies, books, or art work, he or she cannot help but focus on things that are dark and evil. If a person constantly gossips, or listens to gossip, or reads gossip-filled magazines, he or she will not be able to focus on the good in others and in him or herself. How can kids your age follow this advice to think of things that are worthwhile?

5. From which book of the Bible is today's Gospel reading?

Which of today's readings mentioned a vineyard?

Again, this reading is symbolic. Who is the landowner, the landowner's son, and what does the vineyard represent?

6. How many people did you shake hands with during the Sign of Peace?

When you shook each person's hand, did you look them in the eye and clearly say, "Peace be with you?" or another appropriate phrase?
