What symbols of Advent are there in your church, today? (For example, an Advent wreath, a tree, banners or pictures, and so on.)

Do you know what each of the candles stands for? (The third, or rose colored, candle has a special name.)

The Advent wreath is one of many ways to keep the meaning of Christmas alive. If you don't have one at home, make a simple one and put it where everyone will see it

2. From which book of the Bible and chapter is today's first reading?

Do you know who "the voice of one crying out in the desert, 'Prepare the way of the Lord'" is? (Hint: this passage was written hundreds of years before Jesus was born. However, it is a prophecy of someone who lived during Jesus' lifetime on earth.)

3. From which Psalm is today's Responsorial?

4. From which book of the Bible is today's second reading?

According to this reading, when is the end-of-times going to come?

If you believed that Jesus was going to come again tomorrow, what would you do today? How would you act? What would you say to Jesus when He was face to face with you?

5. What did you do, last week, to make your Advent special? What will you do this coming week?
