1. What day is it today in the Church's Calendar?
2. Did you get a palm as you entered your church today?
3. From which book of the Bible is today's first reading taken?
4. From which book of the Bible is today's second reading taken?
5. From which Gospel is today's reading taken?
6. What are some of the things that happened in the Gospel reading today?

In one of the Gospel readings you may or may not have heard, (Mark 15) after Jesus' death the veil of the sanctuary was torn from top to bottom. This was a very heavy curtain forty cubits (around sixty feet) high. It separated the place where the Ark of the Covenant had previously rested. The Ark was a golden box in which the Ten Commandments, Aaron's staff were placed.

7. If you bring your palms back to your Church at a certain time, a few members of the Church will burn the palms. On what day will the ashes be used?
8. Can you list the Sorrowful Mysteries of the Rosary?

*9. Answers to last week's questions: The four Gospel writers (Matthew, Mark, Luke and John) are called the Evangelists. Evangelism means the spreading of the Christian Gospel by public preaching or personal witness.
