3. From which Psalm is today's Responsorial?
4. From which Gospel is today's reading?

What was the name of the Apostle who doubted Jesus' Resurrection? (There are two names for him).

5. Write down one main point from the homily.
6. What color is the priest wearing today?
7. Do you know the namesake of your church or parish (the reason behind its name)?
8. As you grow older, younger kids will begin to look to you for an example. Even though Lent is over, it's still good to make a small sacrifice or do an extra chore. It will make a good impression on younger kids and actually change the way people (even adults) think of you. This week, try to think of someone who could use your help.
9. Do you know who replaced Judas as the twelfth Apostle? (Hint: Many get him mixed up with Paul, who is often referred to as the Thirteenth Apostle).

10. Answer to last week's question: The ashes from the holy palms are saved for the next Ash Wednesday; they are used for the little ash cross you receive on your forehead.
