1. What day is it today in the Church's calendar?
2. What color is Father wearing today?
3. List all the things Jesus is called in today's first reading (Acts 4; 8–12).

Psalm 118:22, Matthew 21:42, Luke 20:17 and Acts 4:11, read (wording may vary) *The stone which the builders rejected, has become the cornerstone.*

A cornerstone is one of the first stones the builders put down. While it does not act as a foundation for the entire building, it still has to be strong and set properly. All other stones will be placed in reference to this stone. How can you act as a 'cornerstone' in your community or for your family and friends?

4. From which Gospel is today's reading taken?
5. What does Jesus call himself in this reading?
6. Who does Jesus say will abandon his 'sheep' at the first sign of danger?
7. Which two Evangelists (Gospel Writers) were Apostles?
8. What is Jesus trying to say in today's Gospel? Write down his main point in your own words.
9. *Answers to last weeks questions: The three synoptic Gospels are Matthew, Mark and Luke. The Gospel according to John is very symbolic, using many light–dark contrasts. Luke is the longest of the four Gospels.*
