Since the Easter season ended on Pentecost, (two weeks ago on May 24th) we are no longer reading about the Resurrection in the Mass readings. Today we actually go back to *before* he died, when He and His disciples celebrated the Passover. This is when Jesus gave us (the Church) the Sacrament of the Eucharist.

7. This Thursday (June 11th) is the feast day of Saint Barnabas the Apostle. He is the patron saint of Cyprus, Antioch, against hailstorms and is prayed to as a peacemaker. St. Barnabas was the one who stood up for Paul when the other disciples did not believe he had converted and were afraid of him. He was Jewish and sold all his property and gave the profits to the disciples after he became a Christian. Some call him the Son of Encouragement and Consolation.
