2. What type of tree is mentioned in today's first reading?

This reading uses trees to symbolize a people. Many books of the Old *and* New Testament use symbolism. The Revelation of John is an example of this.

3. From what book is today's second reading?
4. What does St. Paul tell the Corinthians in this letter?
5. From which Gospel is today's reading taken?
6. To what does Jesus compare faith?
7. This reading tells us Jesus spoke to the people only in *parables*, but told his Apostles what he meant. What is a parable?
8. At what are you best? Each person has a unique gift; maybe a boy is really good at soccer or a girl at writing. What are some ways that you can help other people with your gift?
9. Write the first five books of the Bible in order.

Today is also the feast day of St. Methodius I. St. Methodius was born in Syracuse, Sicily to wealthy parents. As a young man, he was sent to Constantinople (now Istanbul) to continue his education and hopefully gain a lofty position in court. Defying the wishes of his parents, Methodius joined a monastery and later became an abbot.
