Monday is the feast day of St. Thomas More, the patron saint of lawyers. Thomas More was born in London in 1478. After being thoroughly taught in religion, he entered Oxford (one of the oldest cities in England) to study law. In 1505 he married Jane Colt, who died at a young age, leaving him with four children. Thomas More later married Alice Middleton to be a mother to his children. In 1516 he wrote his world famous book *Utopia*. He attracted the attention of King Henry VIII (the eighth) who finally named him Lord Chancellor in 1529. In 1534, he refused to see the king as the head of the Church. He was confined to a tower and beheaded on July 6, 1535.

Answers to last week's questions: A parable is a story with a moral. The first five books of the Bible are Genesis, Exodus, Leviticus, Numbers and Deuteronomy. These are called the Pentateuch or the Books of Moses.
