October 28<sup>th</sup> is the feast day of St. Jude the Apostle. St. Jude, known as Thaddaeus, was a brother of St. James the Less and might have been related to Jesus Christ. St. Jude is not the same person as Judas Iscariot, the Apostle who betrayed Jesus. Jude is mentioned only briefly throughout the Gospels. He wrote the Epistle of Jude found in the New Testament. This is the second to last book of the Bible. He is the patron saint of desperate situations and lost causes. Two saints, St. Bridget of Sweden and St. Bernard, had visions from God asking them to accept St. Jude as "The Patron Saint of the Impossible" when they visited the tomb of St. Jude.

*Answer to last week's question: Isaiah is a Prophetic book of the Old Testament.*
