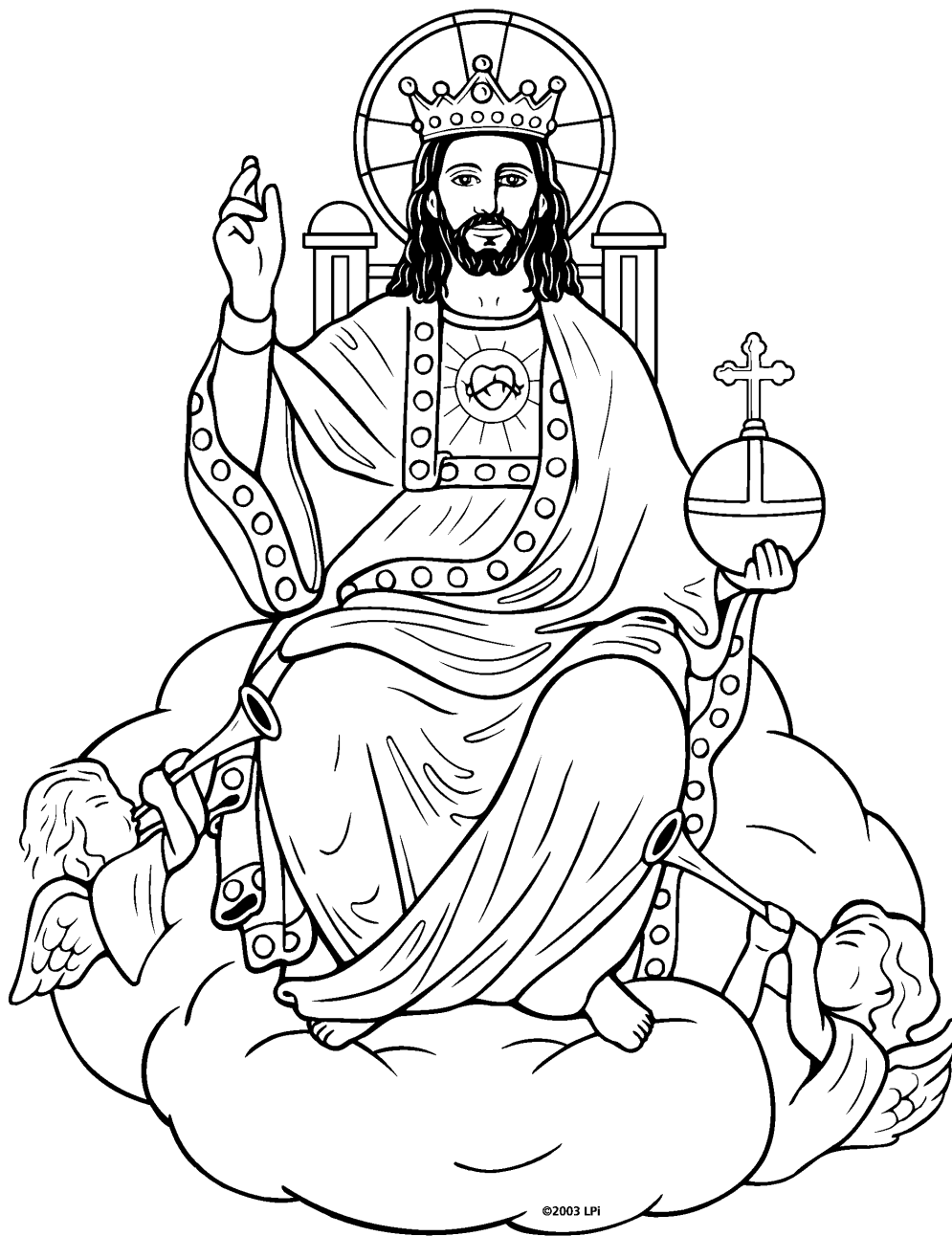

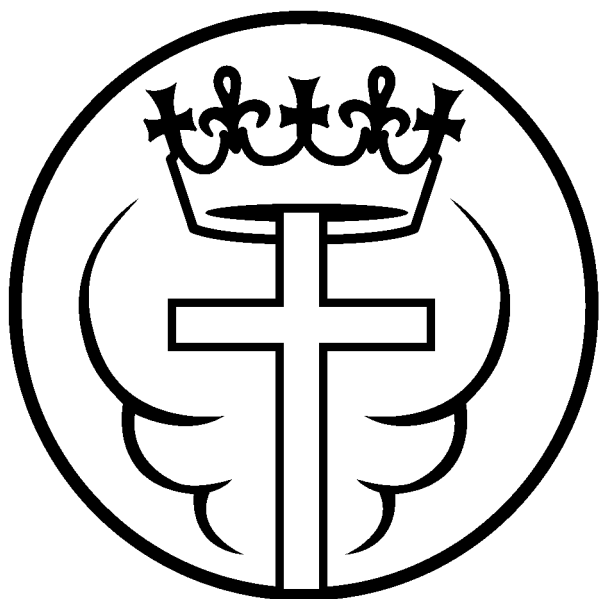
"Jesus answered, "You say I am a king. For this I was born and for this I came into the world, to testify to the truth. Everyone who belongs to the truth listens to my voice."

Our gospel passage for this week is from **John 18:33b-37**. This week, we celebrate the **Solemnity of Our Lord Jesus Christ the King**.

This is a special feast in our Church's calendar - the Priest at your Church will wear either gold or white vestments to show what a special day this is! This is the last Sunday of our Church's year - next Sunday we begin the season of Advent and a whole new liturgical year.

This Sunday, we focus on the triumph of our Savior Jesus Christ. The readings call on us to follow Jesus, our Good Shepherd. In the Gospel reading Jesus reminds us

"everyone who belongs to the truth listens to my voice". With all that is happening in the world around us, let's take time to listen to Jesus' voice, to come to know Him more through prayer, and to read about Him, His life and His
