January 21st is the feast day of Saint Agnus. Born around 291 AD, Agnus (her name meaning 'lamb') was born to a wealthy family. Many offers of marriage were made to her, but she promised God she would never stain her purity. It is said that her reply to such offers was 'Jesus Christ is my only Spouse.' Her faith was reported to the officials and she was condemned to death. On the day of her death, she was said to be as happy as a bride on her wedding day. She is the patron saint of young girls, chastity and the Children of Mary.
