1. What day is it today in the Church's Calendar?
2. From which book of the Bible is today's first reading?
3. The Sixth Station of the Cross is *Veronica Wipes the Face of Jesus*. Is this event mentioned in the Bible?
4. What is symbolized in the Sixth Station by Veronica's small act of charity during Jesus's harsh journey?
5. Does each church use the same number of Stations?
6. Do we pray the Stations any other time during the year?
7. Do the Stations of the Cross have to be prayed in a church?
8. Who helped Jesus to carry His Cross?
9. How many times does Jesus fall during the Stations of the Cross?
10. Do you have a favorite Station? Which one and why?
11. Where was the body of Jesus laid?

Answers to last week's questions: Only an ordained minister can preach the homily. It occurs directly after the Scripture readings. Transubstantiation is the changing of the bread and wine to the body and blood of Jesus Christ. The Consecration is the prayer over the wine and bread to change it. Only a priest can consecrate the bread and wine.
