3. From which book of the Bible is today's first reading taken?

This reading says that "humble" people look for God. What does it mean to be humble?

4. From which Psalm is today's Responsorial taken?

This is one of the Beatitudes: "Blessed are the poor in spirit." What do you think "poor in spirit" means?

5. From which book of the Bible is today's second reading?

What does this passage tell the reader to do?

6. From which Gospel is today's reading taken?

These are called the Beatitudes. Some call them the "Be-Attitudes", because they give us excellent advice. Which one do you think might be the easiest for you to put into action?

Which one might be the hardest for you?

7. Did you notice a common theme in all of the readings, today? What does it tell us about humility and how God wants us to act?
