Today, we celebrate the **Fourth Sunday in Ordinary Time**. We read from **Matthew 5:1-12A**.

In this week's Gospel, Jesus went to the top of a mountain and began to teach the people who were following him. This special part of Matthew's gospel is called "The Beatitudes".

When we first read Jesus' teaching, we might feel surprised! Who wants to feel poor, or sad, or hungry, or thirsty?! But in this gospel, Jesus teaches all of us that it is important for us to care for the world around us and for each other. To be "blessed", we must look for opportunities to be peacemakers, to be people who help those in need, and to be Jesus' love to the world around us. We can do this with small helping acts and also with our loving prayers. So let's rejoice and be glad!
