1. What day is it today in the Church's Calendar? (There are two names.)
2. We celebrate Jesus' wonderful mercy today. What it mean when we say "Jesus' divine mercy?"
3. Jesus wanted everyone to realize how merciful He is, so he appeared to a nun from Poland. What was her name? (It's a hard name to remember, so here are some choices to pick from: Sr. Theresa, Sr. Faustina, Sr. Mary, Sr. Bridget, Sr. Rose.)

Jesus told her to write down a devotion called the Divine Mercy Chaplet. One of the short prayers that she wrote down is:

*O blood and water,
which gushed forth from the heart of Jesus as a fountain of mercy for us,
I trust in you.*

Try to memorize this prayer, and say it each day.

4. Have you seen the Divine Mercy painting? It shows Jesus standing with one hand raised and the other pointing to His heart. From His heart shine two rays of light, one red and one white. Can you see this image in your church, today?

What do the two rays represent?

5. One of the things Jesus asked Sr. Faustina to do was to pray for someone who needed forgiveness, or someone who was lost in the habit of sinning. He wants us to do that, too! Try to pray for someone this week.

6. From which book of the Bible is today's first reading?
