1. What day is it, today, in the Church's calendar?

How many altar servers (acolytes) are helping Father at Mass, today? What are the servers wearing? Albs (a white robe with a cincture/rope around their waist)? Cassocks and surplices (usually a black garment with a short white tunic worn over it)?

2. From which book of the Bible is today's first reading?

After listening carefully to this reading, how would you describe it? Happy and expectant? Sad and discouraged?

3. From which Psalm is today's Responsorial?

The first line of this Psalm is: "The Lord is my shepherd; I shall not want."  
What does this sentence mean, or how does it make you think of God?

4. From which book of the Bible is the second reading?

This reading ties in well with the Responsorial. How do they complement or reinforce each other?

5. From which book of the Bible is today's Gospel reading?

Can you name the four Gospels?

6. Do you spend time praying every day? We can't grow closer to Jesus if we don't spend time with Him! There are many ways to pray. What are some ways that kids your age can include prayer in their busy lives? (For example, pray quietly while standing in line, sit quietly and look at a Crucifix or picture of Mary, write a song for Jesus, pray the Rosary at night, write to Jesus in a journal, and so on.)
