4. How often does the Church ask us to attend Mass?
5. The Mass has a central part, the most important point of the Mass. It's the whole focus of our faith. Do you know what that point is?
6. Not just anyone can consecrate the bread and wine during Mass. In fact, only a few very special people can do it. Do you know who that is?

There is a unique word to describe the moment when the bread and wine become the Body and Blood, Soul and Divinity of Jesus Christ. Do you what that word is? (It's a hard one, so here's a list to choose from. And yes, these are all real Catholic words!)
