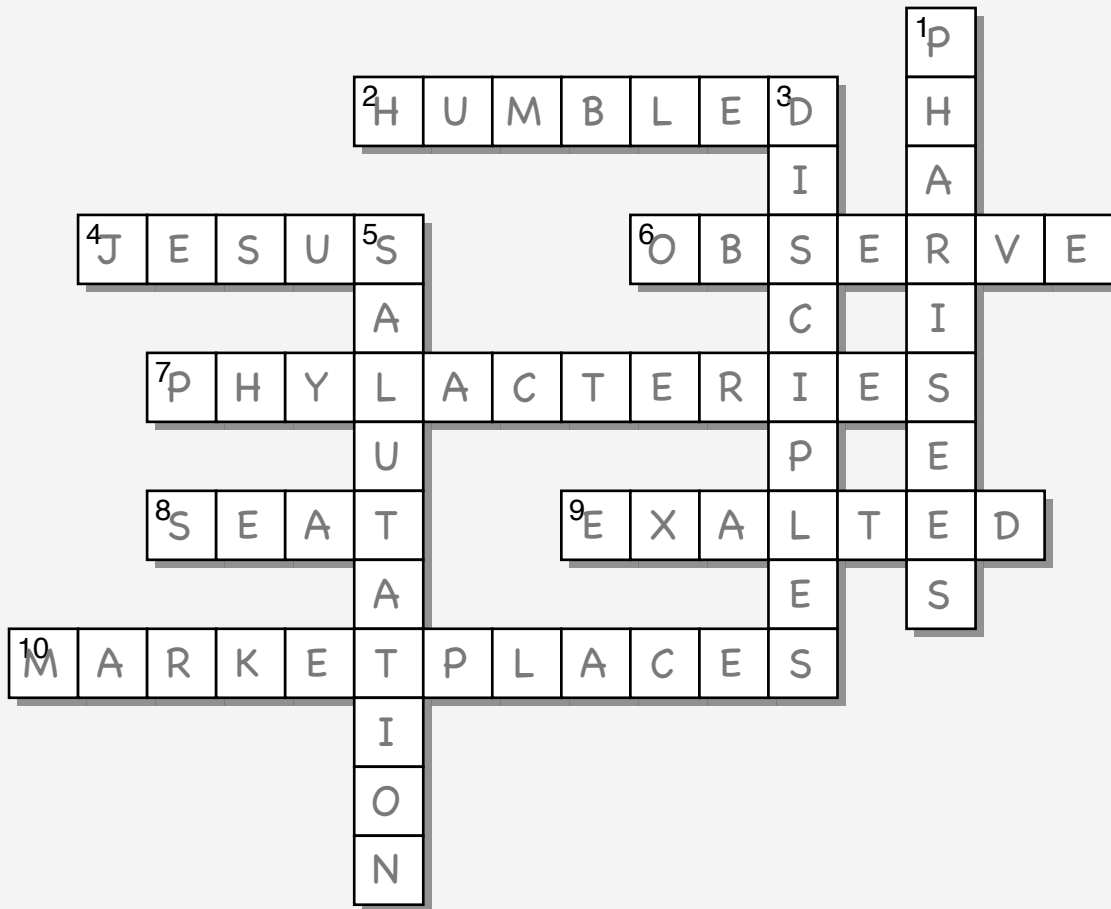


## Thirty-first Sunday in Ordinary Time
