In today's Gospel reading, Jesus tells those listening to him, "Whoever exalts himself shall be humbled, and whoever humbles himself shall be exalted." What does this mean?

When Jesus walked the earth over 2,000 years ago, the men in charge of the temple where Jesus and his family worshiped wore fancy clothes and considered themselves better than those that sought their guidance. They also had rules that made it difficult for people to feel that they were good and obedient to God. Our Heavenly Father could have chosen to send Jesus as one of these men, instead he asked Mary, a humble woman, and Joseph, a lowly carpenter, to raise his only son. Jesus lived a simple life, but a life focused on others – to bring peace of mind and heart, to forgive those who had sinned.
