4. From which book of the Bible is today's first reading?
5. From which book of the Bible is today's second reading?
6. What are the names of the four Gospels? From which one is today's reading taken?

*7. Answer to last week's questions: Moses is found in the Old Testament. He led the Israelites out of Egypt, parted the Red Sea, and wrote the 10 Commandments on stone tablets. He led his people to the promised land, but died before they arrived there.*

*David wrote most of the Psalms, which are found in the Old Testament.*
