Today we celebrate the Second Sunday of Lent. In the Gospel reading Jesus took his disciples Peter, James and John up a high mountain. As they watched, Jesus was “transfigured” (changed) before them and his clothing became a very bright white. With him, the disciples saw Elijah and Moses. Then God’s voice came from heaven saying, “This is my beloved Son. Listen to him.”

The season of Lent is the perfect time for us to practice listening to God’s son, Jesus. When we speak to him in prayer and listen for his response in our hearts, when we read his words in the Gospels, or when we study our bibles to better know his teachings, we follow God’s voice saying to us, “Listen to him.”

- ★ This week, practice your listening skills. Play the “telephone” game at home or make a special point of having a conversation with someone you don’t normally talk to – and really listen to them!
