3. Do you know the name of the first pope?

4. Last week's worksheet discussed the Sacrament of Baptism. Have you seen a person receive Baptism?

5. The Church celebrates the Ascension of the Lord either today or last Thursday. Do you know what the "Ascension" is?

Many people confuse the "Ascension of the Lord" with the "Assumption of the Blessed Virgin Mary". Do you know the difference?

6. Did you recite the Apostles' Creed, today, or the Nicene Creed?

7. Answer to last week's questions: Of the seven Sacraments, the three that can be received only once are Baptism, Confirmation, and Holy Orders. Holy Communion and Confession should be received frequently, and Anointing of the Sick can be received as needed. Marriage is normally only received once in a person's lifetime, but there are exceptions.
