This week we continue reading the Gospel according to Mark. In this Gospel, the Pharisees continue to try to trick Jesus! They want him to say something that would get him in trouble. They do not understand that as the Son of God and filled with the Holy Spirit, all that he says is right and just! He can not be tricked!

Jesus again also has to instruct his friends, the disciples, to change their way of thinking! Remember, women and children during this time on earth were not really important. Here again, Jesus tells his friends that ALL are part of God's Kingdom! *Especially the children!* Jesus not only blesses the children, but tells the adults that they need to have faith like a child to enter into the Kingdom of God!
