Today marks the Fourth Sunday of Lent. Our Gospel this week continues in John where we learn about the miracle of Jesus curing a blind man. At first, the blind man believes that Jesus must be a great prophet to be able to restore his sight. But after being questioned by the Pharisees and speaking with Jesus a second time, the man understands that Jesus is the Christ. Jesus proclaims to him that He is the light for the world. Jesus, and Jesus alone, can bring light to the darkness! Jesus is the Way, the Truth and the Light!

Have you ever sat in a room that is totally and completely dark?

Sometimes we lose power and our homes can be very dark. When Jesus walked the earth there was no electricity. Oil and candles were burned to provide light. It is hard to imagine in 2020 how dark the evenings must have been with no streetlamps or electricity.

Ask your parents to help you create a space that is really dark in your home. Take a flashlight with you or, if you are with a parent, light a candle. Sit for a few minutes and simply say, *"Jesus you are the Way, the Truth and the Light of the World. Walk with me today and everyday."*
